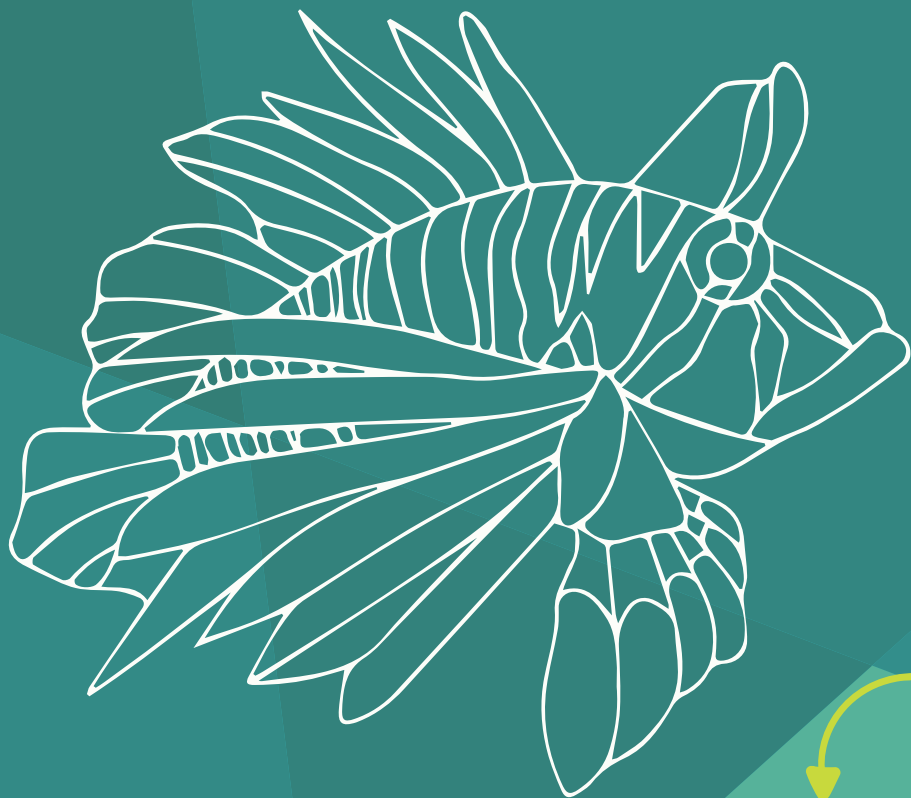


SPOT THE ALIEN FISH

WHY IS THE LIONFISH SUCH A THREAT? GHALIEX IL-LIONFISH DAUGHTER DAQSHEKK PROBLEM?

1. LIONFISH HAVE NO NATURAL PREDATORS IN THE MEDITERRANEAN, AS THEY ARE NATURALLY FOUND IN THE PACIFIC AND ATLANTIC OCEANS. M'HEMMX PREDATORI TAL-LIONFISH FIL-MEDITERRAN GHAX GEJJIN MILL-OCEJAN PACIFIKU U DAK ATLANTIKU.

2. MATURE FEMALE LIONFISH CAN RELEASE UP TO 2 MILLION EGGS EACH YEAR, BECOME SEXUALLY MATURE AT THE AGE OF JUST 1 YEAR AND LIVING UP TO 15 YEARS. IN-NISA JISTGHU JIPPRODUCU SA ŻEWG MILJUN BAJDA FIS-SENA, SA MILL-ETA' TA SENA, U JISTGHU JGHIXU SA' 15-IL SENA

3. LIONFISH ARE AVID PREDATORS THEMSELVES, LEADING TO A SHARP DECLINE IN NATIVE BIODIVERSITY LEVELS. IL-LIONFISH HUMA KACCATURI KBAR HUMA NNIFISHOM U GHALHEKK JWASSLU GHALL-TNAQQIS FIL-HUT U FIL-BIJODIVERSITA

4. LIONFISH ARE VENONMOUS CREATURES WHICH STING AND INJURE NUMEROUS FISH ERS AND DIVERS EACH YEAR AROUND THE WORLD. IL-LIONFISH TNIGGEŻ MINHABBA X-XEWK LI GHANDHA FUQ RASHA U MAL-GARGI LI MINHABBA FIHOM JWEGGHU HAFNA DIVERS U SAJJEDA KULL SENA.

WHAT SHALL I DO TO AVOID GETTING STUNG? X'GHANDI NAGHMEL BIEX MA NITNIGGISX?

AVOID ALL DIRECT CONTACT WITH THE LIVE FISH. REMOVE (BY USING A PAIR OF SCISSORS OR PLIERS) THE DORSAL FINS (THE ONES LOCATED ALONG ITS BACK, ON TOP OF ITS HEAD) AND THE PECTORAL ONES (THE ONES AROUND ITS GILLS) AS THESE CONTAIN VENOMOUS SPINES. USE A PAIR OF GLOVES THROUGH OUT.

WHAT SHALL I DO IF I AM STUNG? X'GHANDI NAGHMEL JEKK NITNIGGEŻ?

- REMOVE PIECES OF THE SPINE. SOMETIMES, PIECES OF THEIR SPINE REMAIN IN THE SKIN AFTER A STING;
- CLEAN THE AREA WITH SOAP AND FRESH WATER. IF YOU HAVE A FIRST AID KIT, YOU CAN ALSO CLEAN THE WOUND WITH ANTISEPTIC TOWELETES;
- CONTROL BLEEDING. USING A CLEAN TOWEL OR CLOTH, APPLY DIRECT PRESSURE TO THE WOUND;
- APPLY HEAT TO HELP THE VENOM BREAK DOWN. USE AS MUCH HEAT AS YOU CAN TOLERATE WITHOUT BURNING YOURSELF. JUST MAKE SURE THE WATER OR HEAT PACK ISN'T TOO HOT! YOU DON'T WANT TO ADD A BURN ON TOP OF YOUR INJURY. KEEP THE TEMPERATURE OF THE WATER BELOW 120°F (48.9°C). APPLY HEAT FOR ABOUT 30 TO 90 MINUTES;
- TAKE PAIN MEDICATION. A LIONFISH STING CAN BE EXTREMELY PAIN FUL, SO TAKE AN OVER-THE-COUNTER PAIN RELIEVER TO REDUCE PAIN. (TYLENOL); THIS CAN INCLUDE IBUPROFEN (MOTRIN) OR ACETAMINOPHEN
- APPLY A TOPICAL ANTIBIOTIC CREAM. THEN BE SURE TO WRAP A BANDAGE AROUND THE WOUND TO REDUCE THE RISK OF INFECTION;
- USE ICE OR A COLD PACK TO REDUCE SWELLING. DO THIS AFTER APPLYING THE INITIAL HEAT THERAPY;
- SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION. IF THE STING CAUSES SEVERE PAIN, YOU MIGHT NEED A STRONGER PAIN MEDICATION. INFECTION IS ALSO POSSIBLE IF OTHER GERMS GET IN UNDER THE SKIN,



WHAT SHOULD I DO IF I CATCH OR SPOT ONE?

KEEP THE CAUGHT INDIVIDUAL FROZEN IF DEAD OR IN A BUCKET WITH SEA WATER IF ALIVE. IF YOU SPOT ONE WHILST DIVING, SNORKELING OR SWIMMING, TRY TO TAKE A GOOD (HIGH-RESOLUTION) PHOTO OF IT, SINCE **THE FIRST CONFIRMED RECORD OF THE LIONFISH FROM MALTESE WATERS WILL EARN YOU A BRAND-NEW GOPRO 7!**

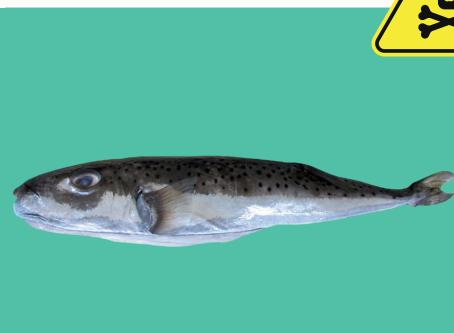

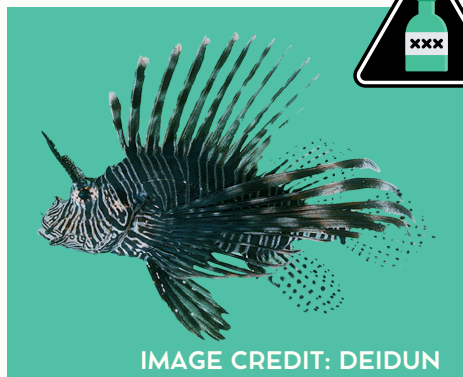

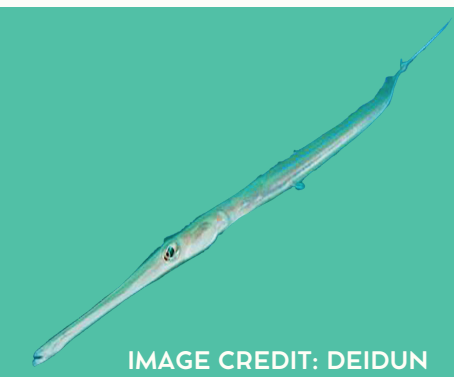

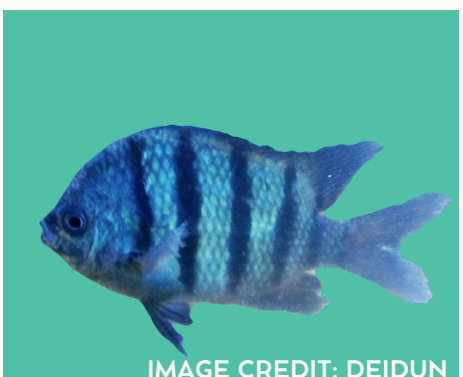
